During the months of April and May each year, the South Carolina State Library Talking Book Services Department offers a fine arts creative outlet for blind and visually impaired students in our state.

It is now time to enter the 2022 SCSL Talking Book Services art competition. Any visually impaired/blind child or young adult still in school may enter. Artwork needs to be tactile in any medium. Only one entry per student is allowed.

There are three age categories: ages 6 to 10, ages 11 to 15 and ages 16 and up. First, Second and Third place are awarded in each category. One piece is selected by the State Librarian to win the Best in Show Award and be permanently displayed in the State Library. All artwork and the attached registration form should be delivered to the SC State Library at 1500 Senate St., Columbia, SC no later than 5:00 pm, **March 4, 2022.** Artwork received after this date will not be eligible for the competition. **Winners will be notified **April 5, 2022.**** If assistance is needed in getting the artwork to the SC State Library, do not hesitate to contact Talking Book Services.

Invitations to the awards ceremony will be sent out to all participants.
